I am requesting funding for the Stockbridge Water Line Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Stockbridge located at 4640 North Henry Boulevard, Stockbridge, GA 30281.

The City of Stockbridge would use this funding for designing, planning, construction, and soft costs (including design fees and task orders) to upgrade the city's water system. Presently, there are recurring breaks in the water main, creating significant interruptions to Stockbridge's commercial district along N. Henry Boulevard (SR 138). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will deliver safe and reliable water services for Georgia residents and provide regional benefits by increasing the interconnectivity of Stockbridge and the Henry County Water Authority.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
