I am requesting funding for the College Park Lead/Galvanized Water Service Line Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of College Park, GA located at 3667 Main Street, College Park, Georgia 30337. The City of College Park would use this funding to replace the current lead/galvanized water pipes with ductile iron pipes suitable to source water for the current community. The proposed six-inch (6") water line will provide an additional 1,000 linear feet. Of that, 730 feet would be the installation of ductile pipe. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide access to clean water to College Park residents, businesses, and the Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta Airport, the busiest airport in the world.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
