I am requesting funding for the Lawrenceville Police Department Equipment and Technology Update Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Lawrenceville Police Department located at 300 Jackson Street, Lawrenceville, GA 30046. The Lawrenceville Police Department would use the funding to purchase four standard police cruisers which would conduct high-visibility enforcement, RTCC hardware, first-aid kits, trauma bags, mechanical breaching kits, a hydraulic breaching kit, a reusable training breach door, 16' telescopic ladders, public safety camera trailers, Bluetooth communication equipment, safety barriers, ballistic shields, gas masks, and tactical camera kits.
